Assembly Members Peter Black and Lorraine Barrett have invited a poet, Patrick Jones, to insult Jesus Christ and call for an end to freedom of religious worship in the National Assembly's Ty Hywel building at 12 noon on 11th December, exactly two weeks before Christmas. The poems to be read include obscene references to the female body and allege, in gutter language, sexual relations between Jesus Christ and Mary Magdalene and between the poet and Christ. Jones also calls for Jewish synagogues to be closed and for churches to be 'morphed into pound shops'. Lorraine Barrett AM is a member of the extreme anti-Christian 'National Secular Society' and Jones himself is a militant atheist. The Assembly should not become a bearpit to express hatred of Jesus. They would not do the same to Mohammed!

Please come and stand up for the holy name of Jesus Christ on 11th December, meeting at 11.30am. How we need to be turning to the Lord at such a time as this, not insulting Him in the corridors of power! We shall sing hymns of praise and invite Church leaders to lead us in prayer. May God send repentance and have mercy on this land of Wales.
